



Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are to ensure that everyone can enjoy themselves safely and securely.

Strictly fly fishing only. No enticing products to be used or thrown into the lake.

Fishing from platforms only

Minimum 6lb leader, maximum hook size 6

Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult

Any fish caught and deemed unfit to be returned to the water must be brought to the lodge for inspection

The lake is designed for peaceful recreation: no bad language, shouting or unacceptable behaviour will be tolerated

Litter must be deposited in the bins provided

A valid rod licence must be held in order for fishing to be allowed

Please note that that we respectfully reserve the right to check all bags/containers etc

We will also be making random inspections of fishing methods

Sporting Ticket Rules

(in addition to the above rules)

As part of our lake management policy, which aims to increase the rate of stock turnover and catch rate, we are no longer offering exclusive catch and release tickets at Cwm Hedd.

We also ask that all anglers on a sporting ticket adhere to the rules regarding killing the first one or two fish.

If there is widespread abuse of these rules we may have to consider stopping all catch and release at Cwm Hedd.
